Subject: Impact Assessment of the 'Make in India' Initiative

Kindly recall that the Make in India Initiative was announced by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 24 September, 2014 to encourage the global community to invest in the manufacturing sector in India. The scheme aims at promoting indigenization and job creation through invitation of FDI accompanied by domestic reforms including skills development and improving ease of doing business.

2. Certain domestic manufacturers made a representation that Chinese Railway Investment Company (CRIC), which is the procurement arm of the Chinese Railway has imposed conditions which mandate an entity to be registered, and have manufacturing facilities in China to become eligible for bidding. This leads to exclusion of many domestic Indian firms from bidding process.

3. The domestic manufacturers have quoted the Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order 2017 of the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) which states that Government of India should encourage the production of goods and services in India with a view to enhance income and employment. Further, the domestic manufacturers have also invoked section 10(d) of the above mentioned policy, which states that "If a nodal ministry is satisfied that Indian suppliers of an item are not allowed to participate and/or compete in procurement by any foreign government, it may, if it deems appropriate, restrict or exclude bidders from that country from eligibility for procurement of that item and/or other items relating to that Nodal Ministry".

4. In order to make an assessment in this regard, Dr. V.K. Saraswat (Member), NITI Aayog has suggested that comparative data for 3 years, both before and after the launch of Make in India scheme which pertains to import/work orders issued to the Companies /Consortiums of different countries may be provided to assess the impact.
